Peter's 2010 book, *Bad Characters: Sex, Crime, Mutiny, Murder and the Australian Imperial Force* was jointly awarded the Prime Minister's Prize for Australian History in 2011. His books include the first book on Indian on Gallipoli (*Die in Battle, Do not Despair – 2-15 –* which dealt with Indian mountain batteries on Gallipoli) and his next book will be '*Terriers in India: British Territorials 1914-19*, also the first to be published on the subject, which deals among other things with the service of British Territorial gunners in the Great War.
